Scholarship Terms & Conditions

Applicants must be:

- Australian citizens or permanent residents of Australia within the meaning of the Australian Citizen Act 2007 (proof of either must be provided if requested).
- Currently residing in Kwinana in the State of Western Australia.
- Completing Year 10, in the year of application, for Year 11 scholarships.
- Enrolled or prepared to enrol and complete Years 11 and/or 12 at Gilmore College, following the awarding of the scholarship.

"The Valk" Scholarship 2021-22

Andy and Rita Valk expressed a preference for the income of the foundation to be used for establishing and maintaining a scholarship(s) to be awarded each year to a student(s) who is/are a resident(s) of Kwinana and who is/are attending an educational institution within Kwinana.

Scholarships will be awarded to students in entering Year 11 or Year 12 who may not have the resources available to achieve their full potential, or to complete their education, or both at Gilmore College. Applicants may be required to complete an Application Form and a Letter of Application in which they explain:

- why they should be awarded the scholarship.
- how being awarded the scholarship will assist them.
- their intended Senior School studies.
- how they can make a positive contribution during their senior years at Gilmore College.
- their ambitions for the future

and submit the application by <u>3.00pm on Wednesday 23 September 2021 to Ms McCaig by email 'MCCAIG Lauren [Gilmore College]' Lauren.Mccaig@education.wa.edu.au.</u>

They must also be aware of their responsibilities as an applicant;

- to complete the application accurately and submit it on time;
- take responsibility to provide their semester 1 report and any other documentation required;
- check emails daily from the close of entry until notification of results;







- reply to emails relating to the scholarship process within 24 hours of receipt;
- be on time and prepared for any interview;
- direct questions relating to the scholarships, to the Year Co-ordinator Ms McCaig.

Any applicants who make a final shortlist may be required to provide:

- proof of citizenship/permanent residency if requested; and
- a copy of their Semester 1 school report.

Selection Criteria

When selecting the recipients, the panel will consider the following:

- The applicant's ability to demonstrate that he/she will provide a positive contribution during their senior years at Gilmore College.
- The applicant's Scholarship specific future ambitions.
